16th International Corrosion Congress in Beijing China, Sept 19-24, 2005

The preparations for the 16th International Corrosion Congress in Beijing are proceeding well. The EC is in close contact with the local organizers (prof Wei Ke and prof Yinshun WU) and the first flyer will have arrived on your desks some months ago. The 16th International Corrosion Congress will be a major event. Please draw the Congress to the attention of corrosion scientists and engineers in your country. A new update of the information will follow soon including more information on the program, the hotel accommodation and social program. Next Council Meeting

The members of the International Corrosion Council will meet in Beijing. The exact time and the meeting room will be posted at the announcements board of the Beijing Congress. Members who can not attend the meeting in person are invited to provide a signed proxy to a member of the Executive Committee or any other member of the Council.

17th International Corrosion Congress 2008

ICC is soliciting for formal invitations by prospected organisers of the next International Corrosion congress. It would be good to have at least two formal biddings available in time, which means before February 2005. The requirements and procedure can be found in the bye-laws on the ICC website www.icc-net.org.

Nominations should be sent to the chairman of the ICC.

The invitations will be presented in detail at the Council meeting in Beijing where the Council members will decide on the location of the 17th International Corrosion Congress.

Election of Vice Chairmen

Marcel Pourbaix Award

The Marcel Pourbaix award recognizes unselfish contributions to international collaboration in the field of corrosion. According to the terms of reference the award winner should have made "an exceptional contribution in promoting the objectives stated in the ICC constitution, in stimulating activity on an international level and in developing cooperation, friendship and support". The EC awaits proposals for this award. The next award recipient will be announced at the 16th International Corrosion Congress in Granada.

Young ResearcherTravel Award

The Travel award for young researchers (see <u>ICC WEB site</u> for details is now available for two young researchers. The award is given personally during the meeting and is thus only available for those chosen candidates that are really present at the meeting.
